

Adding to that is the increasing rate in the number of people living with Alzheimer's disease and related dementias."

The problem: Florida has the second highest number of people with Alzheimer's in the nation.



Family caregivers (also known as care partners) of people with Alzheimer's and related dementias **are at greater risk** for anxiety, depression, and poorer quality of life than caregivers of people with other conditions.

TO LEAVE A LEGACY

Carl Scharfenberg is a member of the Dubin Center Board of Trustees. He was also a Dubin Center client and care partner. Carl interviewed me when I applied for the position of Executive Director. Since I accepted the position three years ago, Carl has volunteered visiting with caregivers in their homes, filmed a commercial for the center, helped the staff

deliver care packages and launched the Men's Support Group in 2022!

He takes time to support each member of the Dubin Center team with an occasional letter or a book with words of support and encouragement and then, a couple of months ago, Carl sent me a letter telling me that he was leaving part of his estate to the Dubin Center! I had the opportunity to visit and interview with Carl and his wife Linda (whom he met in support groups years ago at the Dubin Center) in their home in Fort Myers.

How did you find out about the Dubin Center?

I lived close to the Dubin Center when it was located on McGregor Blvd. I went to the door several times before I ever knocked and went in. At first, I was not ready to ask for help. I have been married three times. My first wife died of breast cancer. My second wife died from Alzheimer's and my third wife, Linda, and I met at a support group at the Dubin Center.

Why and how do you volunteer your time to the Dubin Center?

As a graduate care partner, I know how difficult it can be. When I share my experiences with others, I am passing along things I have learned to help care partners take care of themselves and their spouses. At the same time, I am helping the Dubin Center fulfill their Mission.

What inspired you to leave a legacy gift?

I was doing some updating of our estate plan with our attorney and just thought this might be a way to help the Dubin Center reach more people Southwest Florida. Our home is the largest asset I have, and I arranged for that to go to my two daughters from my first marriage. When the house is sold, they will send 20 percent of the proceeds to the Dubin Center. I thought we could help the Center help more people with dementia. It is unusual because I cannot give the Dubin Center any dates or amounts until I pass away. I just know my daughters will see to it that the Dubin Center will get what their dad planned for the Center.

"What advice do you have for Caregivers (Care Partners)? Learn to say "Yes" when friends ask if they can help you. That can change your life! An offer to bring "Chicken Marsala" from one of my daughter's friends changed mine!!!
